Helicopter		
Equipment hazards associated with helicopters	Exposure to tail rotor and the main rotor system (helicopter blades). Hats, loose clothing, gloves etc, can be sucked into the engine air intake fans and cause the helicopter to malfunction and potentially crash.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Only fully trained personnel in helicopter equipment hazards can have access in helicopter area. Avoid the tail rotor and the helicopter blade area - Never Do Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) to patients on transport carts while the carts are under the helicopter blade. This may elevate height of the personnel to the extent of being hit by the helicopter blades
Fuels	Exposure to fuelling hazards such as fire or explosions occurring from a spark or match in the helipad area.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not smoke at heliport area - Place proper signs - Attach a grounding cable to the helicopter during fuelling, to prevent sparks
